Tacaíonn na tionscnaimh sin le baint amach na gcúig Phríomhspríoc den Phlean Gníomhaíochta don Ghaeilge.</p> <p>Ballraíocht</p> <p>Tá BAI agus Foras na Gaeilge ina gcomhchathaoirligh ar an gCoiste. Ar na baill tá ionadaithe ó RTÉ, TG4, CRAOL, IBI, Léiritheoirí Scáileáin na hÉireann agus Oireachtas na Gaeilge. The aim of the Committee is to develop and promote initiatives that will help increase the levels of Irish available to audiences on both radio and television. These initiatives support the achievement of the five Key Objectives of the Irish Language Action Plan.</p> <p>Membership</p> <p>The Committee is co-chaired by the BAI and Foras na Gaeilge. Membership also includes representatives from RTÉ, TG4, CRAOL, IBI, SPI and Oireachtas na Gaeilge. At the close of 2021, the following members retired from the Committee: Anna Davitt (Foras na Gaeilge co-chair); Máirín Nic Dhonnchadha (Oireachtas na Gaeilge); Muiris Ó Fiannachta (CRAOL). Choimisiúnaigh an BAI i gcomhpháirtíocht le Foras na Gaeilge agus an Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán taighde dhá-pháirteach (cainníochtúil agus cáilíochtúil) agus rinneadh an obair seo le linn 2022.</p> <p>I dtaighde Chéim 1, iarradh tuairimí sampla ionadaíoch náisiúnta den aoisghrúpa 15-34 in Éirinn ar raon ábhar agus ceisteanna a bhaineann le héileamh, ábhar agus rochtain ar sheirbhís raidió Gaeilge. Rinne Ipsos MRBI taighde ar Chéim 1, agus bhí na nithe seo a leanas san áireamh:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>Suirbhé cainníochtúil:</i> Ceistíodh 600 duine óg idir 15-34 bliain d’aois trí shuirbhé Omnipoll. Research to explore interest in, and the potential for, an Irish-language radio service for young people aged 15-34:</p> <p>One of the ongoing activities of the Irish Language Advisory Committee has been to explore interest in, and the potential for, a hybrid model Irish language youth radio station (i.e., via FM and digital broadcasting); in 2021, the Irish Language Advisory Committee recommended that independent research be undertaken to explore the interest in, and potential for, a hybrid Irish-language full-time radio service for young people aged 15-34 in Ireland. A two-phased (qualitative and quantitative) research project was commissioned by the BAI in partnership with Foras na Gaeilge and the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sports and Media and this work was carried out in 2022.</p> <p>Phase 1 research sought the views of a national representative sample of the 15-34 age group in Ireland on a range of topics and questions relevant to demand for, content of, and access to, an Irish language radio service. Phase 1 research was undertaken by Ipsos MRBI, and included the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>Quantitative survey:</i> 600 young people aged 15-34 were questioned via an Omnipoll survey. The survey questions focused on radio consumption, motivations to listen, and potential interest among the general youth audience (mainly those who do not speak Irish as their first language) in a new Irish language service. The survey also included a question on proficiency in the Irish language.2. <i>Review of JNLR and Other Secondary Data:</i> A review of other secondary data was undertaken to consider the wider context of

Soláthraíodh an tuarascáil deiridh i mí na Samhna 2022 agus tá sé le foilsiú go luath in 2023.

I dtaighde **Céim 2** scrúdaíodh tuairimí **chroílucht éisteachta beartaithe na seirbhíse**, .i., cainteoirí dúchais agus líofa Gaeilge agus/nó iad siúd a bhfuil inniúlacht an-mhaith acu sa Ghaeilge a mbeadh rochtain acu ar na meáin Ghaeilge ar bhonn rialta (15-34 bliain d'aois), agus rinneadh iniúchadh níos mine ar an gcineál ábhair fuaimne a bhfuil suim ag an aoisghrúpa seo ann. Rinne Bricolage taighde ar Chéim 2, agus áiríodh ar na gníomhaíochtaí:

1. *Taighde deisce agus Iniúchadh Catagóire*: iniúchadh ar shruthanna éagsúla meán (Raidió Gaeilge, Podchraoltaí Gaeilge, Raidió Náisiúnta/Idirnáisiúnta, Podchraoltaí & Sruthanna) chun Forbhreathnú Catagóire a fháil ar réimse an ábhair fuaimne in 2022.
2. *Agallaimh le Saineolaithe*: Reáchtáladh agallaimh le seisear saineolaithe ó eárnáil na meán cumarsáide chun dearcadh gairmiúil a fháil ar thírdhreach fuaimne na Gaeilge agus na deiseanna forbartha amach anseo.
3. *Staidéar Cáilíochtúil Eitneagrafaíochta ar Éisteoirí Óige*: Rinne Bricolage fócas-staidéar ina raibh 19 rannpháirtí a raibh Gaeilge acu (meascán de cheantair tuaithe agus uirbeacha / Ghaeltachta agus neamh-Ghaeltachta / aoisghrúpaí 18-26 agus 27-34 / cainteoirí dúchais agus neamhdhúchais ach líofa sa Ghaeilge / meascán de staidéanna maireachtála (m.sh., coláiste, ag obair, ag maireachtáil le teaghlach/cairde). Thug na

audio consumption among the 15-34 target audience via an analysis of JNLR listening trends. This was supplemented by the most up to date analysis of platform usage data among the target group and trends in the broader audio market.

The final report was delivered in November 2022 and is due for publication in early 2023.

Phase 2 research explored the views of the **intended core audience of the service** i.e., native and fluent Irish speakers and/or those with a very good competency in Irish who would access Irish language media on a regular basis (aged 15-34) and explored in more detail the type of audio content that this age group is interested in. Phase 2 research was undertaken by Bricolage, and activities included:

1. *Desk research and Category Audit*: an audit on various streams of media (Irish Language Radio, Irish Language Podcasts, National/International Radio, Podcast, & Streams) to obtain a Category Overview of the world of audio content in 2022.
2. *Expert Interviews*: Interviews were conducted with six experts from the media sector to get a professional perspective on the Irish language audio landscape and opportunities for future development.
3. *Ethnographic Qualitative Study of Youth Listeners*: Bricolage carried out a focus study involving 19 Irish-speaking participants (mix of rural and urban / Gaeltacht and non-Gaeltacht / age brackets 18-26 and 27-34 / native speaker and non-native but fluent in Irish / mix of living situations (e.g., college, working, living with family/friends). Participants undertook 5 days of online ethnographic tasks to provide information on:

Tá Céim Eile dírithe ar dhrámaíocht teilifíse réamhscriptithe a fhorbairt, tacóidh Tús le gearrscannánóirí agus tá scéim nua	<p>their home situations, hopes, values and lifestyles, current media diet, what they might look for in the ideal radio show, and their thoughts on Irish language and English media gaps. Six participants were selected for follow up interviews to explore their responses in greater detail and to obtain richer insights.</p> <p>The final report was delivered in December 2022 and is due for publication in early 2023.</p> <p>Next steps: Phase 1 and Phase 2 reports have been considered by the Committee and will be published in Quarter 1, 2023.</p> <p>2. Promoting Irish Language opportunities and resources to address sectoral needs:</p> <p>At the March meeting, members had a discussion regarding current needs/gaps in the sector and looked at various ways the Committee could work together to prioritise and promote Irish language in the industry. A working document was created to list ideas and activities that could be furthered in the course of 2022. Below are details on some actions taken:</p> <p>Members acknowledge the need to attract people with Irish language skills into the broadcasting sector and to develop the skills of existing crews.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">In July 2022 TG4 announced funding schemes that will support new talent in the Irish media sector. Céim Eile is aimed at developing TV scripted drama, Tús will support short filmmakers and a new factual short film scheme is also in the pipeline. The schemes are funded by TG4 in association with Screen Ireland and Northern Ireland Screen's Irish Language Broadcast Fund.

The station also advertises Training & Development opportunities on its website• TG4/BAI/Údarás na Gaeltachta partnership ‘Glúin Nua’ projects were showcased at the Galway Film Fleadh in July and are available via TG4 online platforms. This project is still ongoing with the final series due for completion shortly.• Iriseoirí an Lae Amárach, the online course in journalism for transition year students, was run by TG4, University of Ireland Galway and RTÉ News in 2022. The course encourages young people to consider a journalism career in the areas of TV, radio and Digital.• Foras na Gaeilge promoted Irish language career opportunities for 3rd-level graduates at the GradIreland careers fair at the RDS in September. A dedicated guide ‘Do Ghairm le Gaeilge’ offers careers advice to graduates with Irish Language skills and promotes careers in the Media sector.• BAI undertook to inform 3rd-level students about Irish-language careers in the broadcasting industry when the Sound & Vision Scheme is being promoted in colleges.• Foras na Gaeilge, with support from RTÉ, launched the mentorship campaign ‘Creidim Ionat’ in October 2022, in which high profile personalities committed to improve their Irish over a number of weeks. Members of the public were also encouraged to take part.

Bhí an cheardlann dírithe ar oibrithe deonacha	<p>Radio sector needs were also specifically addressed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oireachtas na Gaeilge, with funding support from BAI, is currently running two initiatives to promote Irish language skills development and encourage the creation of new Irish language content:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Mentorship Scheme for Presenters: Presenters in commercial or community stations who would like to develop their Irish language presentation skills will be paired up with a seasoned mentor who will provide them with ongoing advice and support.○ Workshop series for writers: The workshops will help writers to develop drama scripts as Gaeilge. The resultant programmes will be made available for free to stations for broadcast.• Throughout 2022, Oireachtas na Gaeilge continued its drive to encourage commercial and community stations to register with Gaelpro Raidió so that they can utilise the free resources on offer, including the Eolaire recruitment database and the Central Information Hub with Irish Language resources (self-learn Irish course for presenters; lists of useful phrases; links to other resources, etc.)• BAI and Oireachtas showcased the above resources to IBI stations as part of a webinar information session on 8 June 2022.• CRAOL and IBI are working with BAI to put together a list of station contacts who can be consulted regarding Irish Language matters.• As an initiative for 2022 the Committee made a small budget available so that an Irish Language workshop could be developed and rolled out to CRAOL stations. SPI's website is being developed to include updates as Gaeilge where relevant, to demonstrate the network's support of, and desire to promote, the Irish language. The SPI committee will continue to share news on Irish-language-related initiatives to the Irish Language Advisory Committee for information and promotional purposes.

In December 2022, representatives from Ipsos MRBI and Bricolage attended the Committee meeting to present the findings on Phase 1 and Phase 2 of Irish language youth station research undertaken in 2022.

Concluding Statement

2022 was a year in which we revisited our goals as a Committee and focused on how our actions can support sectoral needs in a practical way. We thank our members for their ongoing contributions to the work of the Committee. It is evident that great efforts are being made to promote Irish Language within the audio and audiovisual sector, not only by the Irish Language Advisory Committee, but among its fellow-committees SPI Irish Language Committee and MLI Irish Language sub-group. We look forward to building on this work and achievements in 2023, a year of ambitious and significant change for media regulation following the enactment of the Online Safety and Media Regulation Act 2022 and the upcoming establishment of a new media regulator Coimisiún na Meán. We look forward to embracing the ongoing and exciting opportunities for Irish language in an ever-evolving media environment.
